Workwear produced with fabrics made of polyester, cotton and cotton/polyester, white, dyed and printed; of cotton/elastane, polyamide, polyester/elastane, cotton/polyester/elastane, white and dyed; of polyamide/elastane, black; interlinings made of cotton and cotton/polyester, white and dyed; metal accessories of brass; accessories made of polyethylene, polycarbonate, POM, polyamide, polypropylene; zips; embroidery threads made of polyester, viscose, aramid and metallized polyester, in different colors; tapes made of polyester, white, dyed and printed, made of rubber/polyester, cotton, cotton/polyester, dyed; retro-reflective polyester bands; polyamide fastening tape in different colors; buttons made of polyamide in different colors and painted; buttons made of polyester, urea, in different colors; buttons made of cotton, white; metal buttons of diecast zinc, iron and brass, electroplated; printed polyamide and polyester labels, woven polyester labels; transparent and colored silicone labels. Raw materials partly pre-certified according to STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX®.

The results of the inspection made according to STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX®, Annex 4, **product class II** have shown that the above mentioned goods meet the human-ecological requirements of the STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® presently established in Annex 4 for products with direct contact to skin.

The certified articles fulfil requirements of Annex XVII of REACH (incl. the use of azo colourants, nickel release, etc.), the American requirement regarding total content of lead in children's articles (CPSIA; with the exception of accessories made from glass) and of the Chinese standard GB 18401:2010 (labelling requirements were not verified).

The holder of the certificate, who has issued a conformity declaration according to ISO 17050-1, is under an obligation to use the STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® mark only in conjunction with products that conform with the sample initially tested. The conformity is verified by audits.
